What is the phonics screening check?

The phonics screening check is designed to confirm whether pupils have learnt phonic decoding to an appropriate standard. Children take the test individually with a familiar trained adult (Mrs Mimms/Mrs Richardson).

It will identify pupils who need any extra help to improve their decoding skills.



When will it take place?

- The screening check will take place throughout the week beginning **Monday 13th June**. The test must be taken during this week.
- The children cannot retake the test at any other time so it is **very important** that your child is in school during this week.
- The children will work in a quiet space, one to one with the adult administering the check.

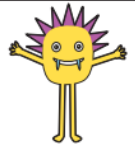

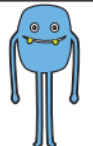
